**JOB DESCRIPTION**

**JOB TITLE: Aquatic Specialist**

**3. WORK CONTACTS:**

He/she works closely with the Associate Dean for University Sports, Director of Athletics, CHSC Supervisors, coaches, students, colleagues within Student Affairs, faculty, other campus constituents and visitors.

**4. INDEPENDENCE OF OPERATION:**

Reports to the CHSC Shift Supervisor. Works according to established policies, procedures, and standards related to the use of the aquatic area. Completed work is checked at a later stage in the work cycle.

**5. SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITY:**

Supervises part-time lifeguards and aquatic programs staff as necessary.

**6. PHYSICAL EFFORT:**

Moderate physical effort involving 75% of work time.

**7. WORK CONDITIONS:**

Slight degree of exposure to health hazards when walking on slippery wet floors.

**8. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

- a. Bachelor's degree plus two years experience in a similar position **OR** Completion of secondary (13 years) education plus five years experience in a similar position.
- b. Certification as a lifeguard, Water Safety Instructor (WSI), CPR and First Aid required; AED preferred.
- c. Good English communication skills are preferred.
- d. Knowledge of instructional techniques and training technology required.
- e. Excellent public relations skills are required.
- f. Willingness to work varying hours with some evenings and weekends required.
